

In consultation with the Eastern Cape Department of Education, Northam has been an ongoing partner in education since signing a Memorandum of Understanding in 2019.

Investment in education

Northam believes that investing in education in the regions where our employees come from creates a significant impact for present and future generations. This also fosters a sense of pride and honours our employees by not only supporting them but also the communities from which they come from.

In 2022, Northam contributed to the improvement of education facilities at Sichwe Primary, Emyezweni Primary and Mbotyi Primary, improving the learning experience of close to 1 600 learners in the Lusikisiki region.

During the current year, Northam made a meaningful difference to Caguba and St. Patrick's Secondary Schools in the OR Tambo Coastal District which will ensure that educators and learners will benefit from quality infrastructure conducive to teaching and learning.

At both schools new classrooms were built, boreholes were drilled, with water amenities and proper ablution facilities installed, as well as general repair and maintenance work completed. In addition, school shoes and socks were donated to each learner.
